Sashastra Seema Bal (SSB) is a Central Armed Police Force under MHA and is mandated to guard Indo-Nepal and Indo-Bhutan borders. Besides, SSB is also deployed for internal Security & Anti Naxal Operations duties in the states of Jammu & Kashmir, Chhattisgarh, Jharkhand and Bihar. The force is in an expansion phase since 2010. Resultantly there are sizeable vacancies in the crucial ranks of Commandant, 2nd in-Command & Deputy Commandant.

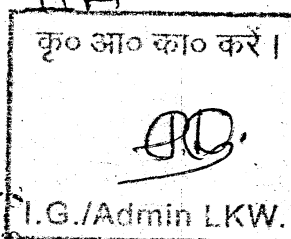

For Commandant:-
Deputation/absorption:

a) By deputation of officers of Indian Police Service or from the Central Reserve Police Force or Central Industrial Security Force or Border Security Force or Indo Tibetan Border Police Force or Assam Rifles holding equivalent post or State Police Officers holding post of Superintendent of Police or equivalent post, preferably with experience of Armed Police duties or officers of Army holding analogous post and are in the Medical category SHAPE-I.

b) **Second-in-Command of Central Armed Police Forces with five years service in the grade with total fifteen years Group "A" service.**

Note-1: The departmental officers in the feeder category who are in the direct line of promotion shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment by deputation. Similarly, deputationist shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment by promotion.

Note-2: The period of deputation including the period of deputation in another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other organisation or department of the Central Government shall ordinarily not exceed three years. The maximum age limit for appointment by deputation shall not be exceeding **fifty two years** as on the closing date of receipt of application.

(ii) Deputy Commandant of Central Armed Police Forces (BSF/CRPF/ CISF/ ITBP/ Assam Rifles) with five years' service in the grade with a total of eleven years Group "A" regular service.

Should be in the Medical Category SHAPE-I.

Note-1: The departmental officers in the feeder category who are in the direct line of promotion shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment by deputation. Similarly, deputationist shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment by promotion.

Note-2: The period of deputation including the period of deputation in another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other organisation or department of the Central Government shall ordinarily not exceed three years. The maximum age limit for appointment by deputation shall not be exceeding **fifty two years** as on the closing date of receipt of application.

G.S.R. 380(E).—In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) and clauses (a) and (c) of sub-section (2) of Section 155 of the Sashastra Seema Bal Act, 2007 (53 of 2007) and in supersession of the Special Service Bureau, Director General, Recruitment Rules, 2003, and the Sashastra Seema Bal Group 'A' Combatised (General Duty) Officers Recruitment Rules, 2004, in so far it relates to the posts of Additional Director General, Inspector General, Deputy Inspector General and Commandant, except as respects things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the Central Government hereby makes the following rules to regulate the method of recruitment to the Group 'A' Combatised (General Duty) posts in the Sashastra Seema Bal under the Ministry of Home Affairs, namely:—

1. **Short title and commencement.**—(1) These rules may be called the Sashastra Seema Bal Group 'A' Combatised (General Duty) Director General, Additional Director General, Inspector General, Deputy Inspector General and Commandant posts Recruitment Rules, 2013.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. **Application.**—These rules shall apply to the posts specified in column (1) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

3. **Number of posts, classification and pay band and grade pay or pay scale.**—The number of the said posts, their classification and the pay band and grade pay or pay scale attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the said Schedule.

4. **Method of recruitment, age limit, qualification, etc.**—The method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating to the said posts shall be as specified in column (5) to (13) of the aforesaid Schedule.

5. **Medical Fitness:**—Only Officers who are in the medical category of SHAPE-1 shall be eligible for appointment on promotion and deputation under these rules.

Explanation.—For the purpose of this rule, the expression "SHAPE-I" shall mean.—

(i) Medical classification done by Medical Officer after assessing fitness of the officer under given factors indicated by the code letters SHAPE, which represent the following function:—

S	-	Psychological
H	-	Hearing
A	-	Appendages
P	-	Physical capacity
E	-	Eye-sight

(ii) Functional capacity of an officer under each factor will be denoted by numeral 1 to 5 against each code letter, indicating declining functional efficiency and the numerals will be written next to the code letter, except that where an officer is in Grade-I in all factors, his category may be denoted by writing SHAPE-I instead of writing S1H1A1P1E1 and general evaluation of these numerals is as under:—

- fit for all duties anywhere;
- fit for all duties but may have limitations as to type of duties and area of employability depending on whether the duties involve severe stress or demand acuity of hearing/vision of both ears and eyes;
- excepting "S" factor, fit for routine or sedentary duties but may have limitations of employability at high altitude (above 2,700 meters) extreme cold areas or hilly terrain and for long assignments;
- temporarily unfit for duties on account of hospitalization or sick leave;

G.S.R. 530(E).— In exercise of the powers conferred by sub section (1) read with clauses (a) and (c) of sub-section 2 of section 155 of the Sashastra Seema Bal Act, 2007 (53 of 2007), the Central Government hereby makes the following rules, in supersession of Sashastra Seema Bal Group 'A' Combatised (General Duty) Officers Recruitment Rules 2004 in so far it relates to the posts of Second-In-Command and Deputy Commandant and Sashastra Seema Bal Assistant Commandant Group 'A' (General Duty) Combatised post recruitment rules, 2010, in so far it relates to the post of Assistant Commandant to regulate the method of recruitment to the Group 'A' Combatised (General Duty) posts in the Sashastra Seema Bal under the Ministry of Home Affairs, namely: -

1. **Short title and commencement.** - (1) These rules may be called the Sashastra Seema Bal Group 'A' Combatised (General Duty) Second-In-Command, Deputy Commandant and Assistant Commandant posts Recruitment Rules, 2012.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. **Application.**- These rules shall apply to the post specified in Column (1) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

3. **Number of posts, classification and pay band and grade pay or pay scale.**- The number of the said posts, their classification and the pay band and grade pay or pay scale attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

4. **Method of recruitment, age limit, qualification, etc.** - The method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating to the said posts shall be as specified in Column (5) to (13) of the aforesaid Schedule.

5. **Medical Fitness.**- Only Officers who are in the medical category of SHAPE-1 shall be eligible for appointment on promotion and deputation under these rules.

Explanation.- For the purpose of this rule, "SHAPE-I" means medical category defined as under:-

(i) Medical classification done by Medical Officer after assessing fitness of the officer under given factors indicated by the code letters SHAPE, which represent the following function:-

S	-	Psychological
H	-	Hearing
A	-	Appendages
P	-	Physical Capacity
E	-	Eye-Sight

(ii) Functional capacity of an officer under each factor will be denoted by numeral 1 to 5 against each code letter, indicating declining functional efficiency and the numerals will be written next to the code letter, except that where an officer is in Grade-I in all factors, his category may be denoted by writing SHAPE-I instead of writing S1H1A1P1E1. General evaluation of these numerals is as under:-

(a) Fit for all duties anywhere.

(b) Fit for all duties but may have limitations as to type of duties and area of employability depending on whether the duties involve severe stress or demand acuity of hearing/vision of both ears and eyes.

(c) Excepting "S" factor, fit for routine or sedentary duties but may have limitations of employability at high altitude (above 2,700 meters) extreme cold areas or hilly terrain and for long assignments.

(d) Temporarily unfit for duties on account of hospitalization or sick leave

(e) Permanently unfit for duties.

6. **Liability of service.-** Any person appointed to the said posts under these rules shall be liable to serve anywhere in India or abroad and perform any work and duty assigned to him there-so.

7. **Disqualification:-** No person, -

(a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or

(b) who having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person, shall be eligible for appointment under these rules:

Provided that the Central Government may if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other grounds for so doing so, exempt any person from the operation of these rules.

8. **Superannuation.**- An Officer appointed under these rules shall retire from service on the afternoon of the last day of the month in which he attains the age of fifty-seven years:

Provided that an Officer whose date of birth is the first day of a month shall retire from service on the afternoon of the last day of the preceding month on attaining the age of fifty-seven years.

9. **Ineligibility of aliens.**- No person who is not a citizen of India shall, except with the prior permission of the Central Government in writing, be appointed under these rules:

Provided that nothing contained in this rule bar the appointment or employment of a subject of Nepal or Bhutan in the Force"

10. **Power to relax.**- Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect of any class or category of persons.

11. **Saving.**- Nothing in these rules shall, affect reservation, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Schedule Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, the Other Backward Classes, Ex-servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the order issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.
