 - (e) Permanently unfit for duties.
- 6. Liability of service.- Any person appointed to the said posts under these rules shall be liable to serve anywhere in India or abroad and perform any work and duty assigned to him there-so.
- 7. Disqualification:- No person, -
- (a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or
- (b) who having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person, shall be eligible for appointment under these rules:

Provided that the Central Government may if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other grounds for so doing so, exempt any person from the operation of these rules.

8. Superannuation.— An Officer appointed under these rules shall retire from service on the afternoon of the last day of the month in which he attains the age of fifty-seven years:

Provided that an Officer whose date of birth is the first day of a month shall retire from service on the afternoon of the last day of the preceding month on attaining the age of fifty-seven years.

9. Ineligibility of aliens.- No person who is not a citizen of India shall, except with the prior permission of the Central Government in writing, be appointed under these rules:

Provided that nothing contained in this rule bar the appointment or employment of a subject of Nepal or Bhutan in the Force"

- 10. Power to relax:- Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect of any class or category of persons.
- 11. Saving:- Nothing in these rules shall, affect reservation, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Schedule Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, the Other Backward Classes, Ex-servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the order issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.
