Subject: Services eligible for long/short-term training programmes under the Domestic Funding of Foreign Training (DFFT) Scheme.

Sir/Madam,

I am directed to refer to the subject mentioned above and to say that at present the officers belonging to the Indian Administrative Service, Central Secretariat Service, State Civil Services, Central Secretariat Stenographers Service (Gazetted) (CSSS) and such officers of the other two All India Services, viz., Indian Police Service and Indian Forest Service and other organized Group 'A' Central Civil Services, who are holding posts on deputation under the Central Staffing Scheme, are eligible to apply for various long term and short-term training programmes organized every year under the DFFT Scheme.

2. It has now been decided to expand the above-mentioned criteria by allowing the officers belonging to Indian Police Service (IPS) and Indian Forest Service (IFoS) to apply for long term and short-term training programmes under the DFFT Scheme even when they are not holding posts on deputation under the Central Staffing Scheme.

3. This provision will be applicable for the training programmes to be organized from the year 2015-16 onwards.
