



BRIEF ON THE PRESENTATION OF THE IPS ASSOCIATION BEFORE THE SEVENTH CENTRAL PAY COMMISSION **ON 16 JUNE 2014**

Dated the June, 2014

The Seventh Central Pay Commission vide its letter dated 06.06.2014 invited the office bearers of the IPS (Central) Association for a preliminary interaction on 16th June 2014.

Being the first interaction it was decided to use the occasion as an exercise of understanding each other and to show case the role and importance of the Service and to provide a preliminary indication of the nature of the memorandum we are going to present कि पहानिरोह । in due course. The detailed memorandum of our demands is to be submitted by 15th July and a detailed presentation be made before the Commission at a subsequent date. Accordingly a brief presentation was made which was followed by a discussion. The Commission gave a patient hearing to our presentation and was inquisitive in knowing about the field conditions not only of the IPS officers but also of the subordinate officers including constables. CIPSA has assured that our memorandum will reflect the conditions of service of all ranks and the problems faced by them, as desired by the Commission.

The Commission readily agreed to the CIPSA suggestion for visit to various theatres of action in the Country for better appreciation of responsibilities, challenges and work conditions of the IPS Officers, as well as visit to some state police Hqrs unlike last time when visits were confined to CAPFs. Additionally, the Commission has been requested to meet state IPS Association office bearers when they undertake field visits.

- In the light of interaction held, it has been decided that;
 - (i) Committees (formed vide meeting date 03.04.2014) should submit their reports latest by 25th June, 2014.
 - (ii) It was also felt that the following issues need greater analysis and inputs. Nodal Officers along with the subjects are listed below:--

In this regard, a meeting with the senior serving officers and the retired officers who had earlier worked on the Pay Commission issues is also proposed to be held in the **first /second week** of July.
