प्रिय महोदय,

पुलिस रेडियो शाखा के कर्मचारियों को दण्ड दिये जाने विषयक कृपया पुलिस मुख्यालय के नोटीफिकेशन संख्या:-नव-१०७-४७ दिनांक:-०६-१०-४९ का अवलोकन करें।

उक्त नोटीफिकेशन में यह व्यवस्था दी गयी है कि पुलिस रेडियो शाखा के कर्मचारियों के विरुद्ध दण्डात्मक कार्यवाही करने हेतु प्रशासनिक नियंत्रण पुलिस रेडियो शाखा के अधिकारियों का है। जनपद के पुलिस अधीक्षक अपने अधीनस्थ नियुक्त रेडियो शाखा के कर्मचारियों को विशेष अनुशासनहीनता के मामलों में यदि आवश्यक हो, तो निलम्बित कर सकते हैं, किन्तु इसकी सूचना उनके द्वारा अग्रिम कार्यवाही करने हेतु तत्काल पुलिस रेडियो शाखा के अधिकारियों को दी जायेगी। इसी प्रकार जहाँ पर अनुशासनहीनता के साधारण मामले होंगे उसके सम्बन्ध में पुलिस अधीक्षक/सेनानायक हेडकान्सटेबिल तथा कान्सटेबिल के समकक्ष श्रेणी के रेडियो शाखा के कर्मचारियों को आदेश कक्ष में पुलिसरेगुलेशन के प्रस्तर ४७८ (सी)(डी)(ई) व (एफ) में उल्लिखित दण्डों से दण्डित कर सकते हैं।

इस सम्बन्ध में निदेशक (रेडियो संचार) उ०प्र० लखनऊ ने पुलिस मुख्यालय को यह सूचित किया है कि उक्त निर्देशों का सम्बन्धित अधिकारियों द्वारा अनुपालन नहीं किया जा रहा है और प्रायः जनपद के पुलिस अधीक्षक अपने अधीनस्थ नियुक्त रेडियो शाखा के कर्मचारियों के विरुद्ध विभागीय कार्यवाही सम्पादित कर उन्हें दण्डित कर देते हैं जो न केवल नियम के विरुद्ध है अपितु इससे अनेक विधिक कठिनाईयाँ भी उत्पन्न हो जाती हैं।

अतएव भविष्य में ऐसे मामलों में विधिक कठिनाई उत्पन्न न हो इसलिए आप कृपया पुलिस मुख्यालय के उक्त सन्दर्भित नोटीफिकेशन दिनांकित:-०६-१०-४९ का पुनः भली-भाँति अध्ययन कर लें तथा उसमें निहित निर्देशों का कडाई से अनुपालन सुनिश्चित करायें।

DISCIPLINARY CONTROL OF THE W.T. PERSONNEL

In supersession of the orders issued in notifications no. XVIII-107-47, dated September 24, 1947 published at page 313 of the Police Gazette, dated October 1, 1947, and no. XVIII-107-47- dated February 7, 1949 published at page 82 of the Police Gazette dated 16 Feb, 1949 the following instructions are issued for the information and guidance of all concerned:

- (1) The A.I.G. P.A.C. will have all the powers of a Range D.I.G., with respect to disciplinary control over the W.T. personnel.
- (2) All disciplinary control over the W.T. personnel will be exercised by the Wireless Officer, W.T. Section, Lucknow. The Assistant Wireless Officers will assist him and will exercise all the powers of a Deputy Superintendent of Police as provided in Police Regulations.
- (3) All Disciplinary powers as provided in the P.A.C. Act will be exercised entirely by the Wireless Officer, W.T. Section only.
- (4) All proceedings under section 7 of the Police Act will be conducted by the Wireless Officer, W.T. Section, Lucknow, himself. The senior most Assistant Wireless Officer will be given the powers of punishments provided in paragraph 479(f) of the Police Regulations.
- (5) All ~~days~~ leave whether privilege or casual to the W.T. personnel will be sanctioned only ~~by~~ by the Wireless Officer, W.T. Section and subject to his control by the Assistant Wireless Officers.
- (6) The Superintendents of Police of the districts in which W.T. personnel may happen to be located for operational duties may exercise only the following disciplinary control over the W.T. personnel:
  - (a) In case of petty breaches of discipline in which the Superintendent of Police considers that immediate disciplinary action should be taken, the Superintendent of police of the district will have the power to inflict punishment provided in paragraph 479(c)(d)(e) and(f) of the Police Regulations. Even in such cases if the Superintendent of police considers that no harm should be done if the matter is referred to the Wireless Officer W.T. Section for disposal, it will be desirable for the Superintendent of police concerned to refer such cases also to the Wireless Officer, W.T. Section, Lucknow.
  - (b) The Superintendents of police of the districts will have powers to place W.T. personnel under suspension in case of serious breach of discipline when suspension is considered essential. Immediately after placing men under suspension, all the facts will, however, be reported to the Wireless Officer, W.T. Section Lucknow for final disposal of the case. The W.T. personnel when placed under suspension, will, be ordered to live in the Reserve police lines of the district concerned and it will also be open to the Superintendent of Police, if considered necessary, to confine the personnel to quarter-guard till final disposal of the case by the wireless officer W.T. Section.
  - (c) Although all cases of leave will be ultimately dealt with by the Wireless Officer, W.T. Section, but in cases of extreme urgency (e.g. accident, illness (etc)) the Superintendent of police of the district concerned may grant casual leave upto 7 days at onetime provided sufficient operators are left in the station to carry on the work. In such cases the Wireless Officer, W.T. will be immediately informed.

2. It is emphasised that although the Wireless Officer, W.T. Section with his Head Quarters at Lucknow is ultimately responsible for the discipline of the W.T. personnel, it is expected that District Superintendents of police will themselves ensure that proper discipline is maintained by the W.T. personnel in their districts. Towards this end, they have been given sufficient powers to deal with the men on the spot in extreme cases but it will result in better maintenance of discipline if the Superintendents of police of the districts maintain close contact with the wireless officer, W.T. Section when dealing with disciplinary cases.
