Subject:- Submission of Annual Immovable Property Return by the IPS officer in the prescribed format - Reg.

Sir.

I am directed to refer to Department of Personnel & Training Office Memorandum No. 104/33/2005-AVD.I dated 07.09.2011, wherein it has been emphasized that Vigilance clearance shall be denied to an officer if he fails to submit his annual immovable property return of the previous year latest by 31st January of the following year, as required under Government of India decisions under Rule 16 of the All India Services (Conduct) Rule, 1968.

It has been observed that several IPS officers have not indicated the date of submission their IPR as prescribed in the format. Non availabilities of date of submission of IPR would result in denial of their vigilance clearance for various purposes such as for empanelment to the various levels at the Centre, Central Deputation, award of Police Medals, etc. While uploading the IPR of IPS officers the State Government may therefore ensure that the IPS officers have invariably पुलिस महानिदेशक के। त्रवादाह्म ted the date of filing of their IPR in the prescribed format itself. The officers who 28 अर्थि submitted their IPR for the year 2014 within the prescribed time limit i.e. by 31.01.2015 and have not indicated the date of filing of IPR in their IPRs itself, may be asked to indicate the date in their IPRs. The concerned State Govt. is requested to re-upload all such IPRs in respect of IPS officers and also forward a hard copy of each IPR to this Ministry.
