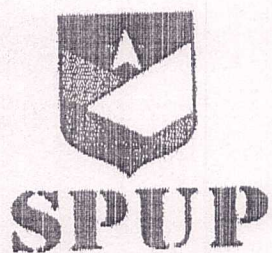

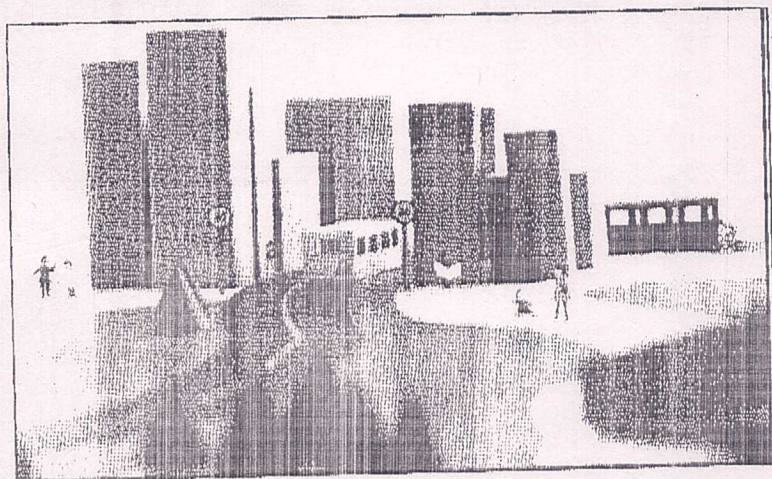

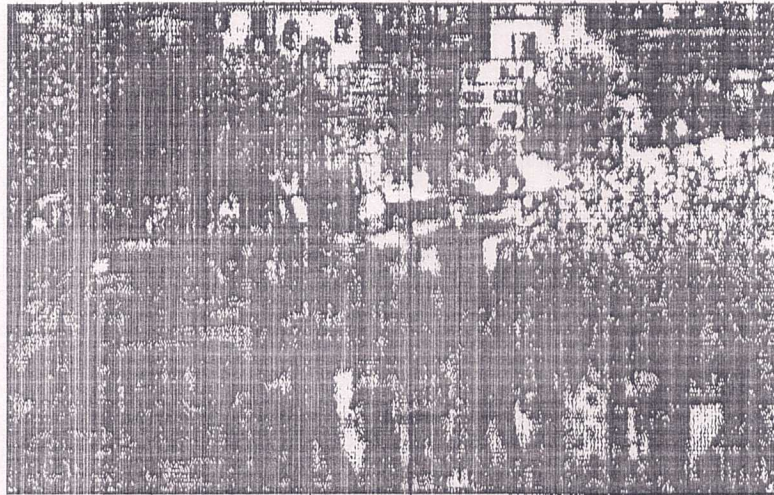

**Background:****Third UN Global Road Safety Week – 2015****#SaveKidsLives**

On 10 April 2014 a new UN General Assembly (UNGA) resolution - "Improving global road safety" - requested WHO and the UN regional commissions to facilitate organization of the Third UN Global Road Safety Week in 2015.

The UN Road Safety Collaboration has announced the global campaign for the Third UN Global Road Safety Week, 4-10 May 2015, on the theme children and road safety: #SaveKidsLives.

The centre piece of the #SaveKidsLives campaign, which was launched in November 2014, is a Child Declaration, developed with input from children around the world.

The campaign invites all road safety policy-makers and advocates to "sign it", "show it", and "deliver it" to those in charge of road safety in countries and communities during the Week.

Every day more than 500 children lose their lives in traffic crashes globally. Thousands are injured. Support the campaign by signing the declaration. Together we will make a call for action on road safety.

As milestone events on the global road safety calendar, UN global road safety weeks give added impetus to the Decade of Action for Road Safety 2011-2020 and its goal: saving 5 million lives.



Thus Centre for Road Safety, Sardar Patel University of Police, Security and Criminal Justice, Jodhpur in joint association with Centre for Child Protection and Centre for Women Studies and Social Defense, SPUP is proposing to organize a 2 day "National Conference on Child & Women Safety : "Save Kids Lives" during UN Global Road Safety Week 2015.

Objectives:

- a. The Conference seeks to highlight the vulnerability and safety concerns of children and women on the Indian roads.
- b. To generate action to improving and enhancing their safety on roads and around educational institutions.
- c. To promote the inclusion of safe and sustainable transport in the post-2015 development agenda.
- d. To support Child Declaration by encouraging stakeholders to sign it, show it and deliver it to those in charge of road safety in country and communities during the Week.
- e. To prepare Road map and action plan of Pilot project to be implemented in selected cities of Rajasthan.
- f. To deliberate on ways to promote and support road safety education among school students in an effective manner.
- g. To share and adopt best practices of Road Safety across the Nation.

Proposed Dates: 6<sup>th</sup> – 7<sup>th</sup> May 2015

**Expected Outcomes:**

- The Conference is designed to have wider impact to highlight the problems and probable solutions for safer school vehicle and public transport fleets.
- National Advocacy group would be formed to do advocacy to better ensure women and child safety by promoting safe road infrastructure and sustainable transport facilities.
- Higher level of commitment to road safety by school managements.
- Responsive road safety authorities.
- Developing of consensus on measures related to safety of children on roads and around campuses.
