Sub: Declaration of Assets and Liabilities by AIS Officer under Section 44 of the Lokpal and Lokayuktas Act, 2013- extension of last date for filing of revised returns by AIS officers - Reg.

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Please refer to this Ministry's letter of even number dated 14.1.2015 regarding furnishing of information relating to assets and liabilities by IPS officers under Section 44 of Lokpal and Lokayuktas Act, 2013.

2. Now, DoPT vide their letter No. 11017/03/2014-AIS III dated 23rd January, 2015 have conveyed that the <u>annual Assets and Liabilities for the year 2015</u> are also required to be filed by the AIS officers in revised format as per sub-rule 2 of Rule 3 of the Public Servants (Furnishing of Information and Annual Return of assets and the limits of Exemption of Assets in Filing Returns) Rules, 2014, which provides that "Every public servant shall file declaration, information or return, as the case may be, regarding his assets and liabilities as on the 31st day of March every year, to the competent authority as referred to in clause (c) of sub-section 2, on or before 31st day of July of that year. DoPT has also clarified that in accordance with provisions of Rule 16 of AIS(Conduct) Rules 1968, the AIS officers shall continue to file Immoveable Property Returns (IPR's) till the time necessary amendments are carried out in the AIS(Conduct) Rules 1968 in order to harmonize them with the provisions of the section 44 of the Lokpal and Lokayuktas Act, 2013. It is, thus, reiterated and clarified that IPRs indicating the position as on 1.1.2015 are required to be filed on or before 31.1.2015.

The Members of service are now required to file the following in the current year:-

(a) Declaration, Information and Return relating to his assets and liabilities as on 1st day of August, 2014 by 30thApril, 2015 and

(b) Subsequently as on 31st March, 2015 by 31st July, 2015.

4. In view of the above, it is requested that these instructions may be widely circulated to all concerned and strict compliance for filing IPRs under AIS(Conduct) Rules 1968 as well as annual returns under the provisions of the Lokpal and Lokayuktas Act, 2013 within the prescribed time limit may be ensured.

Sub:- Submission of Immovable Property Return for the year 2011 (as on 1.1.2012) by IPS officers.

In terms of Rule 16(2) of All India Services (Conduct) Rules, 1968, every member of the service shall submit his/her Immovable Property Return (IPRs) in the prescribed form by 31st January of every year in respect of the previous year ending 31st December.

- 2. It has been brought to the notice of this Ministry that some IPS officers have already submitted their IPRs to the State Governments, but the same have not been forwarded to the Ministry of Home Affairs.
- 3. It is hereby informed that the IPS Officers who had already submitted their IPRs to the State Governments and yet their name are appearing in the defaulting officers list, such Officers are advised to submit a copy of their IPRs directly to the Ministry of Home Affairs (IPS.II Section, Room No. 219-A, North Block) New Delhi-1.

Please refer to this Ministry's earlier letters regarding submission of Annual Immovable Property Returns by AIS officers for the year 2011 (as on 01.01.2012) for placing in the public domain.

- 2. It has been specifically mentioned in the earlier letters on the subject that the IPS officers who have not submitted IPRs in time, would be denied vigilance clearance and will not be considered for promotion and empanelment for senior level posts in Government of India.
- 3. The IPRs for the year 2011 (as on 01.01.2012) received from the IPS officers are posted in the website of MHA. The names of the IPS officers whose APRs are yet to be received by the Ministry of Home Affairs, Gol for the year 2011, cadre-wise, have been posted in the website of this Ministry (http://mha.nic.in/pend_acrs.htm). A list is enclosed.
- 4. The position regarding non-submission of IPRs for the year 2011 by IPS officers was reviewed by the Ministry in the light of instructions issued by DoP&T and in accordance with AIS (Conduct) Rules, 1968. In order to avoid delay in receipt of IPRs, the following be complied with:-
 - (a) The IPS officers who have not submitted the Property Returns for the year 2011 be advised to submit the same immediately.
 - (b) IPS officers who have not submitted their IPRs for the year 2011 will be denied vigilance clearance for promotion, empanelment, other nominations for training, awards etc.
 - (c) The PARs for 2011 duly completed be forwarded to this Ministry by 15.07.2012.
- 5. The above position may please be brought to the notice of all officers concerned for guidance and strict compliance.
