The use of advanced DNA fingerprinting technology is employed in forensic Science for solving criminals or victims.

A 2-days workshop on "DNA Fingerprinting" scheduled to be held in the S.V.P. National Police Academy, Hyderabad from August 17-18, 2015 for the IPS officers of the rank of Superintendent of Police & above from the States/UTs who are supervising the activities of the Forensic Science Laboratories and officials of Judiciary and Prosecution will also participate.

he objective of the workshop is to enable the participants:-

To promote the use of DNA technology (such as DNA fingerprinting, in various areas relating to social welfare, including crime and civil matters, plant and animal stock improvement, certification of cell lines, detection, prevention and treatment of diseases, etc.

- To provide a platform to formulate guidelines on standards, quality assurance, proficiency testing, and accreditation of laboratories and methods related to DNA technology and the periodic review of these guidelines.

- To bring together practitioners of DNA fingerprinting and other related technologies from different disciplines of science, medicine, social sciences and law for furtherance of their objectives through mutual interaction.
