The Human Resource factors for the success of e-governance are:

- A political and administrative leadership sensitized to the transformational potential of e-Governance.
- Specialized skills within the Government to conceptualize and manage e-Governance projects and empowerment of those entrusted with e-Governance responsibilities.
- Engagement of the rank and file of employees and their willing support in the transformational process.
- a Ahility to draw in the heat talent from the private sector and academia

HR interventions and policies are required to address the challenges in each of the above categories, with a focus on developing a specialized pool of talent in the Government, for managing e-Governance projects in the country.

While external talent needs to be inducted to complement the human resource pool in the Government, in-house expertise for e-Governance should be organically grown in the Government by identifying officers with the right attitude, aptitude and capability, and building their skills through training and other capacity building interventions.

Training in e-Governance should be repositioned as an in-service mandate linked to career progression at all levels in the Government in line with the National Training Policy of the Government of India (2012).

The following priority areas have been identified to strengthen the capacity building initiatives:

- Continuing and expanding the current canadity huilding areason
- e Developing and implementing a Comprehensive Training Framework
- Developing Communities of Practice (CoP) to provide subject matter expertise and support the training initiatives

Capacity Building: For e-Governance to succeed in India capabilities must be built at all levels starting from the top leadership to the user of e-Governance services. It is equally important to foster an attitude and mindset that is receptive to ICT based administration and delivery of services. While designing the NeGP, Government of India (GoI) recognized the importance of building capacities to conceptualize, initiate, implement, manage change and sustain e-Governance initiatives. The overall objective of the program is to prepare the participants to play an effective support role in the conceptualization, design and implementation of e-Governance projects and to develop broad strategies for implementing e-Government programs at the state and country level.





Faculty Members:

The program will be delivered by experienced and well qualified faculty members from IGDTUW, NIELTT, Government Officials and Industry Practitioners working on e-Governance projects.

Eligibility Criteria:

Only female candidates are eligible to apply for this course.

- Eligibility criteria for the course for Govt, sponsored candidates: Officers/officials who are graduate in any field or discipline having an executive/professional experience of at-least two years. The cut-off date for counting experience shall be 29th May, 2015. Central & other State Govt., PSUs and Private Organizations could sponsor their employees through proper channel.
- Eligibility criteria for the course for Industry sponsored candidates: Bachelors degree in any discipline with minimum percentage of 60% with a basic knowledge of computer system with minimum of two years of industrial experience. The cut-off date for counting experience shall be 29th May, 2015. Diploma/ Certification in computer applications will be an added advantage. Preference shall be given to persons with experience in IT field/IT industry.


