7. Acceptance: The NPA will confirm the acceptance of nominated officer and Joining Instructions will be sent directly to the officers whose nominations are accepted.
8. Reporting: Officers nominated for the course on receiving confirmation from the NPA are required to report at National Police Academy, Hyderabad one day prior to the commencement of the Course. (Please see Para-1).
9. Accommodation: The course is residential and the participants of the course will be accommodated in SOs/GOs Mess of National Police Academy. The expenditure on account of travel of officers for attending the course may be borne by the States Government/CPOs.
