MHA, vide their note No.23011/16/2014-PT dated 27/07/2015 has approved SOP for award of Union Home Minister's Trophy for Best police Training institutions. As per the Scheme running trophies will be awarded to the Best Training Institutions of States/UTs in each of the following Categories along with an amount of ₹ 25 lakhs as Grant-in-aid for their infrastructural development:

- Best Training Institute for training of Gazetted officers
- Best Training Institute for training of Non-Gazetted officers ii.
- Best Training institute for training of other Ranks (Constables) iii.

- Each States/UT can nominate one Training Institute in each category. 3.
- Further details and procedure for nominations may be seen in the Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) enclosed. (SOP may be seen at BPR&D website under the link "Training' --- 'Union Home Minister's Medal...').
- The Trophies for the inaugural year will be awarded on the occasion of Republic Day Celebrations i.e. on 26.01.2016 for the performance in 2014-15.

- 6 (a). Before the selection at National level, the nominated training Institution will have to compete in Zonal level. For Zonal level, following six zones have been formed and the States/UTs are included in one of the Zones as given in the appendix.
 - North Zone (Haryana, Himachal Pradesh, J&K, Punjab, Rajasthan)
 - Central Zone (Chhattisgarh, Uttar Pradesh, Delhi/Manipur/(UTs), Uttrakhand)
 - North Eastern zone (Meghalaya, Mizoram, Nagaland, Sikkim, Assam Tripura, Arunachal Pradesh)
 - Western Zone (Gujarat, Maharashtra, Madhya Pradesh, Goa)
 - Southern Zone (Telangana, Andhra Pradesh, Tamil Nadu, Kerala, Karnataka)
 - Eastern Zone (Bihar, Odisha, Jharkhand, West Bengal)
- (b) The nominations of States/UTs for each category will first be assessed by the Zonal committee to be detailed by DG, BPR&D for each Zone and the Zonal Committee will select one training Institute in each category from each zone for national level Competition.
- (c) The winner of the training institute at Zonal level in each category will be given an amount of ₹10 lakhs as Grant-in-aid for its infrastructural development.
- 7. At national level nominees of the Zonal level will be assessed by another committee (Separate committee for each category) to be constituted by DG, BPR&D.
- 8. Therefore, Heads of Police Forces are requested to send nomination of one Training Institute for each category separately in Annexure 'A' of the SOP duly filled along with marks in each Test Areas/Sub Areas.
- 9. Nominations must reach Director (Training), Bureau of Police Research and Development, 4th Floor, Block-11, CGO Complex, Lodhi Road, New Delhi-110003 along with all necessary enclosures by September 15, 2015. STANDARD OPERATING PROCEDURE FOR AWARD OF TROPHIES UNDER THE SCHEME "UNION HOME MINISTER'S TROPHY TO THE BEST POLICE TRAINING INSTITUTION".

1. Ministry of Home Affairs, Govt. of India has instituted a scheme for award of Trophies under the scheme "Union Home Minister's Trophies to the Best Police Training Institution" in the country. There will be six Trophies in all for the Best Police Training Institutions in the country, three for the CAPFs/CPOs training institutions and three for the States/UTs Police training institutions. The Trophies will be awarded every year for the performance during the previous financial year.

A. AWARD OF TROPHY TO THE BEST CAPF/CPO TRAINING INSTITUTION

- 2. Every year three Trophies will be presented to the winner of Best Police Training Institutions of the CAPFs/CPOs. There will be three categories for the Trophy viz. Best Training Institute for the training of Gazetted Officers, Best Training Institute for the training of Non-Gazetted Officers and Best Training Institute for the training of Other Ranks (Constables).
- 3. Each CAPF/CPO can nominate one institute for each category every year (Financial Year). The winner institute of the year cannot be nominated for the next two years, in case the institutions are plural in numbers. The Training Directorate of BPR&D would invite the nominations from 15th May of every year. The nomination of the Institute should reach to the BPR&D by 15thJuly in accordance with prescribed format.
- 4. A running Trophy will be presented to the winning Institution in each category as a token of encouragement along with a cash prize of Rs. 25 lakh as Grant in Aid.
- 5. The Head of the Trophy winning Institution of all categories namely Director of Academy, DIsG of NGO and Constable will be selected for Home

Minister's Disc, entirely based on tenure in the particular year of contribution. For example if Director/Principal had tenure in 2014-15 in any CAPF, that person who has maximum working tenure (excluding leave) in the year would be receiving the Home Minister's Disc. There shall be no nomination as well as discretion of the Heads of the CAPF's/Training Directorate in the matter.

- 6. The Head of the Trophy winning institution will be awarded Home Minister's Disc. The Design of Home Minister Disc is exactly as that of DG's Disc of DG, BPR&D. In total there shall be 3 numbers of Home Minster's Commendation Disc.
- 7. The claim of the Institute will be verified by a Team constituted by DG, BPR&D. A separate team for each category will be constituted. The Team will visit each institute qualified for the award of Trophy and verify the claim, the Team will submit the report to DG, BPR&D latest by 15th November of the year.
- 8. The composition of Team would be as under:
- i. Chairman ADG of one CAPF (on rotation basis)
- ii. Member IG of another CAPF (on rotation basis)
- iii. Member-Representative of Police-I Division, MHA
- iv. Member DIG of another CAPF (different CAPF On rotation basis)
- v. Member Representative of Training Division of BPR&D
- 9. The winner of the Trophy will be declared by 15th December of every year and the Trophy will be awarded on the Occasion of Republic Day Celebrations.

B. AWARD OF TROPHY TO THE STATES/UT'S TRAINING INSTITUTION

1. Every year three Trophies will be presented to the winner of the Best Police Training Institution of the States/UTs. There will be three categories for the Trophy viz. Best Training Institute for the training of Gazetted Officers, Best Training Institute for the training of Non-Gazetted Officers and Best Training Institute for the training of Other Ranks (Constables).

- 2. Since there are twenty nine (29) States, Six Zonal Committees would be formed by DG, BPR&D every year in consultation with the DG's of the States. The name of the Zones along with the name of the States/UTs is given at Annexure -B. These Zonal Committees will be formed by 15th May of every year by DG, BPR&D.
- 3. Each state can nominate one institute for each category every year (Financial Year) for the Zone .The winner institute of the year cannot be nominated for the next two years, in case the institutions are plural in numbers. The Training Directorate of BPR&D would invite the nominations from 15th May of every year. The nomination of the institute should reach to Zonal Committees by 15th July in accordance with the prescribed format. The Trophy winning institute at the Zonal level can participate every year if it is not declared winner at the National level.
- 4. The Head of the Trophy winning institution of all categories namely Director of Academy, DIsG of NGO and Constable will be selected for Home Minister's Disc which will be entirely based on tenure in the particular year of contribution. For example if the Director/Principal had tenure in 2014-15 in any Training Institute, that person who has maximum working tenure (excluding leave) in the year would be receiving the Home Minister's Disc. There shall be no nomination and discretion of the Heads of the CAPF's/Training Directorate in these matter.
- 5. The winners at the Zonal level will be awarded Rs. 10 lakh each for the infrastructure development as Grant-in-Aid.
- 6. The composition of Zonal Committees would be as under:
- i. Chairman IG of one state (on rotation basis of the same zone)
- ii. Member-Representative of Police-I Division of MHA
- iii. Member -DIG of another state (on rotation basis of the same zone)
- iv. Member -SP/DC of another state (different state on rotation basis of the same zone)
- v. Member Co-opted member by the committee as expert

- 7. The Zonal Committee of one Zone will visit the institute falling in another zone for verifying the claim of the institutes.
- 8. Every Zonal Committee will select one institute in each category as a winner of the zone for the participation at National level. The Zonal Committees will submit recommendation to the DG, BPR&D latest by 30th September of the year.
- 9. A running Trophy will be presented to the winner at National level in each category. As a token of encouragement, each winning institution at National level will also be given a cash prize of Rs. 25 lakh as Grant in Aid.
- 10. The Head of the Trophy wining institution at National level will be awarded Home Minister's Disc. The Design of the Home Minister's Disc is exactly as that of DG's Disc of DG, BPR&D.
- 11. The claim of the qualified institute of the Zonal level will be verified by the Team constituted by DG,BPR&D. A separate Team for each category will be constituted. The Team will visit each institute qualified for the award of Trophy and verify the claim. The Team will submit the report to DG, BPR&D latest by 30th November of the year.
- 12. The composition of the Team at National level would be as under:
- i. Chairman ADG of one state (on rotation basis)
- ii. Member IG of another state (on rotation basis)
- iii. Member- Representative of Police-I Division of MHA
- iv. Member DIG of another state (different state on rotation basis)
- v. Member Representative of Training Division of BPR&D
- 13. The winner of the Trophy at the National level will be declared by 15th December of every year and the Trophy will be awarded on the Occasion of Republic Day Celebrations.

M number of indoor instructor and N number of outdoor instructor each of M+N = numbers of Instructors can get numerous rewards in terms of Sl no. 1,2,3,6 and the limitation is only for serial no 4 and 5 and to some extent serial no. 7, hence there cannot be any maximum number quotient here will be the total marks of rewards divided by M+N.

As a case study if X institute has 10 indoor and 100 outdoor and all indoor faculty has 2 commendation, 2 DG Disc, 1 Police Medal for meritorious service, 1 distinguish service, 1 hard duty medal and similarly each outdoor has 2 each cash reward and DG Disc and 10 numbers has PMG and 50 numbers has police hard duty medal then the score here will be like the following:-

- 10x2 + 10x2 + 10x1 + 10x2 = 70 for Indoor.
- 100x(2+3) + 10x(6) + 50x02 = 500+60+100 (660) for Outdoor.
- 70+660 = 730/110 = 6.7 (so it cannot be more than approx. 10)
