1. The Academy is organizing a 02 weeks "Courses on Tactics-50" at National Police Academy, Hyderabad as per schedule given below:-

2. The training objectives of the course are to make the participants:-
 - (a) Conversant with the conduct of tactical operations in militancy infested areas including urban, rural and jungle areas.
 - (b) Conversant with the minor tactics and basic drills of CI Ops.
 - (c) Conversant with use of geographical area and weapons to their tactical advantage.
 - (d) Aware about latest technologies in terms of weapons including non-lethal options, communication equipment, body wear/armor, tentage and ration items to sustain prolonged operations.
 - (e) Aware about importance of engaging with the community in insurgency/naxalism prone areas for success of CI Ops.

3. Participation Level.

- (a) Directly recruited IPS officers (ASP & SP) with minimum 3 years of service.
- (b) Directly recruited Dy SPs from States with minimum 3 years of service.
- (c) Directly recruited officers (AC & DC) from CPOs with minimum 3 years of service.
- (d) Promotee State service officers can also be nominated if they are willing and physically fit and are serving with any special task forces.



(This course has been strongly recommended for officers eligible for MCTP Phase-III vide Joint Secretary (Police-I), MHA GOI DO No. 23011/79/2009-PT dated 1st October, 2010. Copy of the above DO is enclosed)

4. **Eligibility.** Since this course involves strenuous exercise in the Jungle, the participants nominated for this course should be physically fit and preferably below 40 years of age. The maximum age limit for nomination is 45 years subject to willingness and physical fitness of the nominee. The officers nominated for the course are advised to undergo morning jog/brisk walk for 1-2 kms per day for 10 days prior to the course to prepare themselves to under take 5 to 8 kms of tactical move in the jungle.
5. **Venue.** National Police Academy, Shivarampally, Hyderabad, PIN – 500052.
6. **Nominations.** 3 seats each have been allotted to all States/UTs/CAPFs. As per seats allotted, nominate officers for the course including one reserve by **10th September 2015**, with details of their cadre, full address including fax/telephone numbers and e-mail address so as to reach the SVP, National Police Academy, Hyderabad. Reserve Officers are to be kept ready for last moment replacement. Otherwise "Reserve Officers" may be nominated for next course. **Nominations to be sent to "National Police Academy" on Fax No 040-24015179 for further acceptance and approval.**
7. **Acceptance.** The NPA will confirm the acceptance of nominated officer and Joining Instructions will be sent directly to the officers whose nominations are accepted.
8. **Reporting.** Officers nominated for the course on receiving confirmation from the NPA are required to report at National Police Academy, Hyderabad one day prior to the commencement of the Course. (Please see Para-1)
9. **Accommodation.** The course is residential and the participants of the course will be accommodated in SOs/GOs Mess of National Police Academy. The expenditure on account of travel of officers for attending the course may be borne by the States Government/CPOs.
10. **Dress Order.** The dress order for the Indoor sessions is tucked-in full sleeves shirt with tie and trouser with formal shoes for gentlemen and saree/salwar kameez for ladies. The dress order for Outdoor sessions is dungaree/round neck T-shirt with track bottom.
