Sub: **IPS Induction Training Course for SPS Officers from 30<sup>th</sup> November, 2015 to 8<sup>th</sup> January, 2016 - Inviting nominations.**

Sir,

A 6-week "IPS Induction Training Course (ITC-32)" is scheduled to commence at the Academy from 30<sup>th</sup> November 2015 to 8<sup>th</sup> January, 2016. The Course is meant for the IPS Officers inducted from State Police Service (SPS) and who have not attended the Induction Training Course at this Academy in the past.

2. As per Govt. of India, Ministry of Home Affairs Fax Message No.1-18012/3/ 2002-IPS dated 17<sup>th</sup> April, 2002; completion of IPS Induction Course at SVP NPA is a compulsory pre-condition for confirmation of promotee officers in the IPS.

3. The Objectives of the Course are to enable the participants

- i) to acquire an all India perspective,
- ii) to equip them with knowledge and skills required to manage a district charge, and
- iii) to enable them to develop an understanding of modern Management principles as applied to police working.

4. The inputs in the course are mainly in the following areas:

- a) All India Services and Administrative set up.
- b) Managing the District.
- c) Interpersonal skills and self development.
- d) New dimensions of policing.
- e) Recent Advances in Police work.
- f) Management concepts relating to Police.
- g) Science and Technology in Police work.

5. During the Course, the participants will be sent on study tour for 10 days to various places / cities in the country. Therefore, the nominated officers may please be paid T.A. advance of Rs.40,000/- (Rupees forty thousand only) to meet their Air / train fare etc.

6. The Programme is residential and the participants of the Course will stay in the accommodation provided by the Academy. The expenditure on account of boarding and lodging of the participants will be met by the Academy.

7. Eligibility: IPS Officers inducted from State Police Service (SPS) (including those working on deputation in CPOs) and who have not attended the "Induction Training Course" at this Academy in the past are eligible for the 32<sup>nd</sup> ITC.

8. Nominations: It is requested to nominate 3/2/1 eligible IPS (SPS) officers of the rank of SP & above to attend the proposed course as per the table:-

2.	Assam, Haryana, Jammu & Kashmir, Kerala, Odisha, Punjab, Himachal Pradesh, Delhi and Telangana: (9 x 2 = 18)	02 from each State
3.	Arunachal Pradesh, Chhattisgarh, Goa, Jharkhand, Manipur, Meghalaya, Mizoram, Nagaland, Pondicherry, Sikkim, Tripura, Uttarakhand: (13)	01 each

9. If any state desires to send more nominations from the above quota, it may do so. In such case, excess nominations will be accepted by NPA against vacancies caused by non-filling of the seats due to any reason.

10. The nominations may kindly be sent as early as possible and latest by 31<sup>st</sup> October, 2015 for acceptance & mailing joining instructions to them. The officers nominated for the Course are required to reach at the Academy on 29<sup>th</sup> November, 2015 evening.
