


6. **Nominations:** Each state/ CAPF / Organisation has been allotted 03 seats. As per seats allotted, nominate three officers for the course as detailed and one more as reserve, well in advance, with details of their cadre, full address including fax/telephone numbers and e-mail address so as to reach the SVP, National Police Academy, Hyderabad. Reserve Officers are to be kept ready for last moment replacement. Otherwise "Reserve Officers" may be nominated for next course. Nominations to be sent to "National Police Academy" on Fax No 040-24015179 on or before 15th December, 2015 for further acceptance and approval.
7. **Acceptance:** The NPA will confirm the acceptance of nominated officer and Joining Instructions will be sent directly to the officers whose nominations are accepted.
8. **Reporting:** Officers nominated for the course on receiving confirmation from the NPA are required to report at National Police Academy, Hyderabad one day prior to the commencement of the Course. (Please see Para-1)
