**MEMORANDUM**

A Course on 'Airport Security and Counter Terrorism' for officers of the State/UT Police, CISF, CRPF, BSF, NSG, AAI, Air India, R & AW and IB is scheduled to be held from May 30 to June 03, 2016 at NIA-Cum-North Zone Regional Training Centre(NZRTC), Dwarka, New Delhi.

2. The course covers various aspects of Civil Aviation Security and Counter Terrorism and would be very useful for officers deployed on Airport Security duties.

3. We shall be able to accommodate officer(s) from your State/UT/Organization/Bureau in this course. In this connection, while nominating the officers as well as reserve officers, you are requested to keep the following points in view: -

- i) The nominated officer(s) should at least be a graduate having proficiency in English to understand lectures and take down notes.
- ii) Minimum four years of service completed.
- iii) Completion of mandatory induction training.
- iv) Must not have attended any course during last two years.
- v) Completion of probation.
- vi) Service having been confirmed.
- vii) Higher rank, higher numbers of years of service and such other parameters on higher side as deemed necessary, be given preference.
- viii) Must have more than 05 years of service left.
- ix) Officer(s) nominated for the course should not be below the rank of or equivalent of SI/Inspector, the course would also be useful for Police security officers of the rank of Superintendent and Deputy Superintendent or equivalent, who have airports in their jurisdiction. **Nomination may**

only be sent in respect of officers preferably dealing with Airport Security or likely to be posted for Airport duties.

- x) It may be ensured that nominated officers are relieved to attend the course and their nomination is not cancelled at the last minute to avoid under utilization of the course.


4. The nominated officers should be advised to read books pertaining to Civil Aviation Security as pre-course training.

5. Specially State police officers who are deployed for temporary duties at airports where non-scheduled aircrafts mostly operate may specially be nominated for this course.

6. A copy of the object of the course and joining instructions is enclosed at **Appendix- A& B.**

7. Only those nominees who fulfil the conditions stipulated at Para 3 above would be accepted for the course. **The nominated officers should not be relieved(R) not be relieved for the course unless positive confirmation of acceptance for the course is received from us.**

**OBJECT OF THE COURSE ON 'AIRPORT SECURITY & COUNTER TERRORISM'**

The object of the above mentioned course for the nominated officers employed in airport security duties is to familiarize themselves with the following aspects of civil aviation security in order to make them capable of carrying out their duties effectively.

- a) History of unlawful interference with civil aviation.
- b) Various threats currently faced by civil aviation e.g. hijacking, sabotage, and terrorist activities and measures to be taken to deal with such threats.
- c) Theoretical and practical aspects of security checks at airports.
- d) The 'Modus Operandi' of hijackers, saboteurs and other terrorists.
- e) Role of Civil Aviation Organization, both international and national.
- f) Objectives of the Civil Aviation Security Organization within the country.
- g) International Laws relating to civil aviation and civil aviation security.
- h) Contingency planning.
- i) Threat to the aviation security from various Militant/Terrorist Groups.
- j) Various other aspects associated with Airport Security and Counter Terrorism.

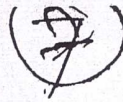
APPENDIX - B
